2021 Annual Meeting and Election

The Nominating Committee has submitted the following names for the positions currently available for our Board of Directors:

- **Mark Bodley**, Incumbent - Director Mark Bodley is from Los Banos. He received his Bachelor of Arts and Master's Degree from Western Colorado State University, Gunnison, Colorado with majors in Accounting and School Administration. He was the Assistant Superintendent for Business of the Los Banos Unified School District until he retired in 2008.

- **Susan Walker**, Incumbent - Director Susan Walker grew up in Merced and attended Merced area schools. She worked for the Merced County Office of Education for 30 years and retired December 2008 as the District Services Payroll Manager. She is a past member of the California Association of School Business Officials and was on the Board of Directors for the Merced Girls Softball League for 24 years.

- **David Nannini**, Incumbent - Director Dave Nannini was born in Dos Palos and raised in Merced. He attended Merced College where he received his Associate of Arts Degree in Business. He started his career in the tire business in 1974 and opened his own business, Tire World, in 1997. He has been on the Board of Directors of Merced Youth Baseball for over 38 years.

- **Wayne Hague**, Incumbent - Director Wayne Hague grew up in Willoughby, Ohio. He attended college at Miami University, Oxford, Ohio and finished at Chapman College with a Masters Degree in Education/Psychology. He served 20 years in the US Air Force as a navigator/pilot before retiring in 1974 and taught for 33 years in the Merced City School District. He is currently a Merced Rescue Mission Counselor.

Nominations and Voting Bylaws

Nominations for vacancies may also be made by petition signed by one percent of the membership. Each nominee by petition shall submit a statement of qualification and biographical data with the petition. Nominations by petition must be filed with the Secretary of the Credit Union no later than January 26, 2021. Nominations cannot be made from the floor unless insufficient nominations have been made by the nominating committee or by petition to provide for one nominee for each vacancy to be filled. No election will be held if there is only one nominee for each position to be filled. If there are additional nominations by petition for any of the positions to be filled, an election will be conducted by ballot at the annual meeting.
