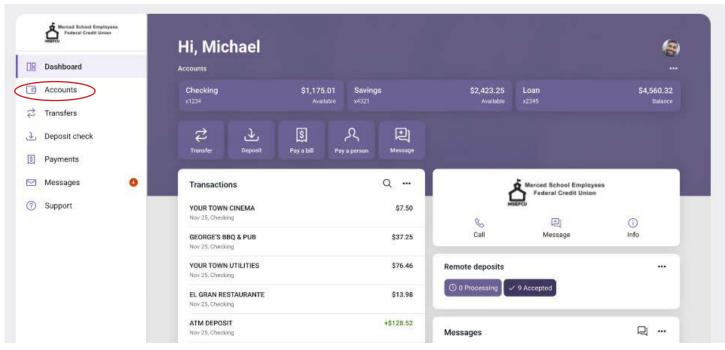

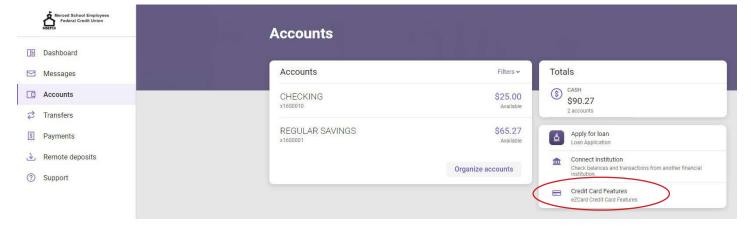
Click on Accounts

After logging in to cu@home, click on the Accounts tab located in the main menu..



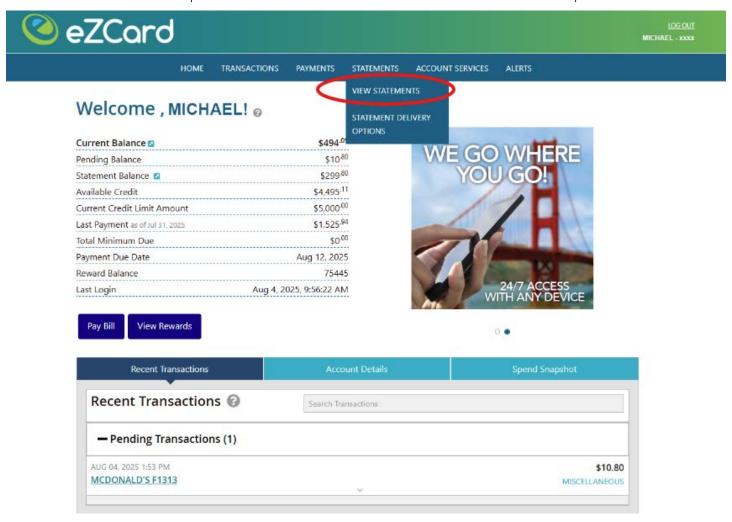
Click on Credit Card Features

In the Accounts section, select Credit Card Features on the right-hand side of the page.



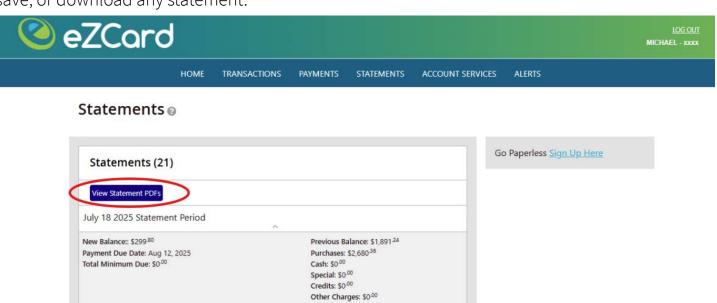
eZCard Info Portal

The Credit Card Features button will take you directly to your eZCard Info portal. Once there, hover over Statements in the top menu bar and select View Statements from the dropdown menu.



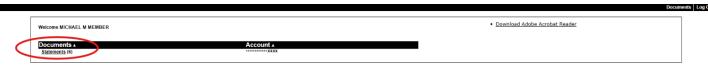
View Your Statements

Your statements will be arranged by Statement Period. Click View Statement PDFs to select, save, or download any statement.



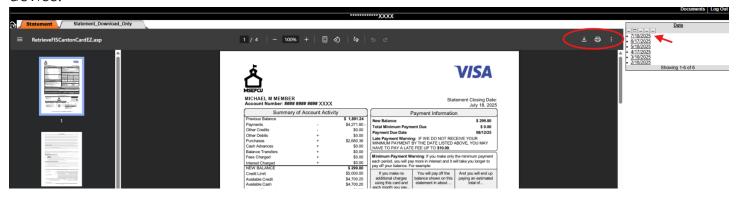
Click on Statements

Choose the statement you want from the date list on the right, then save or download it to your device.

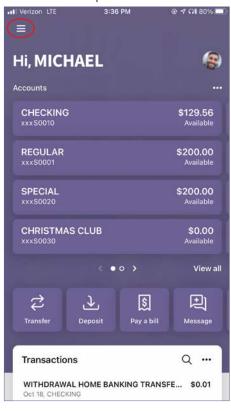


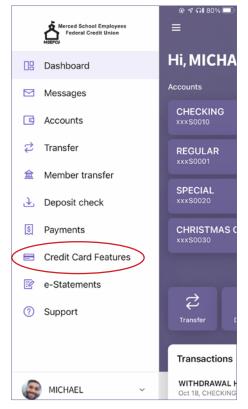

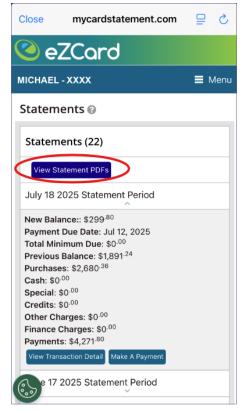
In your eZCard Info portal:

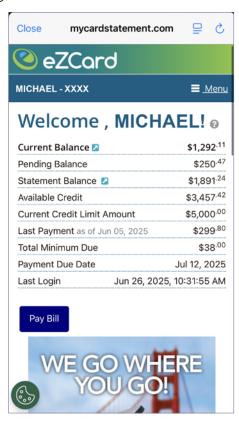
- 1. Tap the Menu (three lines) in the top corner.
